

**THE NAGALAND (REQUISITION OF PORTERS)
(AMENDMENT) ACT, 1995.**

(THE NAGALAND ACT NO. 2 OF 1995)

to further amend the Nagaland (Requisition of Porters) Act, 1965. (Act, No. 7 of 1965)

It is hereby enacted in the Forty Sixth years of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. Short title, extent and Commencement.

- (i) This Act may be called the Nagaland (Requisition of Porters) Amendment Act, 1995.
- (ii) It extends to the whole of Nagaland.
- (iii) It shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of section 2 of the Nagaland (Requisition of Porters) Act, 1965:

For clause (a) of section 2 the following shall be substituted; namely:

(a) Emergency includes a situation where under a public servant is unable to deal with a calamity or threatened calamity such as fire, flood, famine, earthquake, Violent epidemic or epizootic diseases, invasions by animals insects, or vegetable pests, and in general any circumstances that would endanger the existence or the well-being of the whole or part of the community for want porters to carry any essential items of equipment and stores and to a place not connected by road or rail.
